Exit Hansom Court, turn right, cross by The Union, then King Street to Lower Bond Street. Climb the steps to Atkins Building where a cafe and gallery is found.

Leaving the art, retrace your steps to where 'sugary doughnuts are sold in rows'. You'll find this shop painted in orange and graffiti opposite The Union.
